Bewire were invited to provide a full duties building services solution for the proposed new sports hall and teaching facility, Packwood already had a sports hall, but this was dated and did not allow the school to excel in as many different sports as possible..

The challenge was to develop in consultation with the project team a sports hall fully compliant with the recommendations of Sport England whilst working within a very tight budget, this was done and moreover the design was fully compliant with the legislation imposed by the Energy Performance Building Directive (Building Regulation Part L2), all this was achieved "in house" and signed off by our internal Low Carbon Consultant.

The infrastructure for the site was pre determined, this meant that the services type and selection had to be within these tight limitations. This was achieved by careful design and calculation at a very early stage in the design process.

Bewire provided full drawings and specifications for the services and also project managed the services installation right through the tender and construction stages of the project.

The project was delivered on time, and to budget and fully compliant with all recommendations
